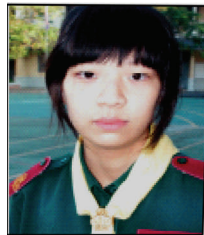

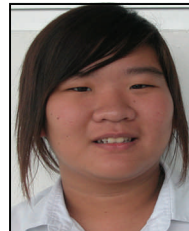

Fever is caused from viruses so there are no medications or antibiotics that can cure them.

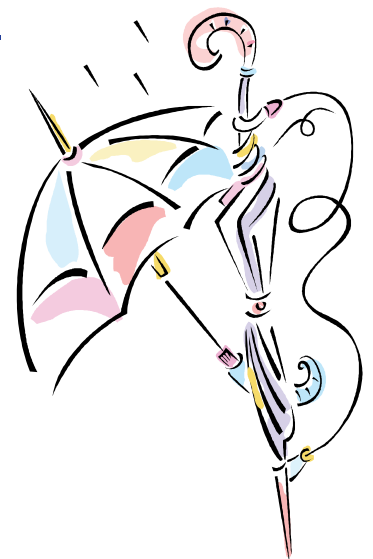
**How to take care of ourselves if we get the flu:**

# “Teacher Interview”



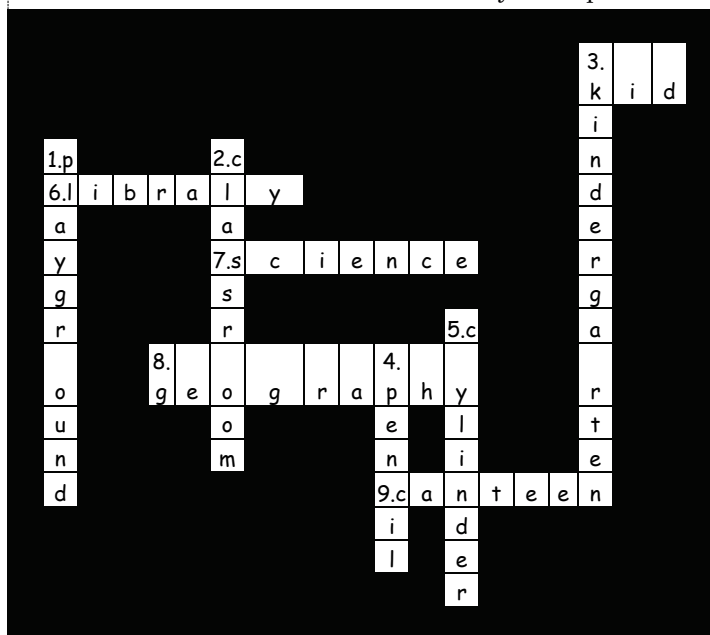
